In accordance with Taiwan's "Bilingual 2030" Policy, the "NYCU x PeiYing English and Culture TA Program" is a semester-round program co-hosted by the Office of International Affairs (OIA), NYCU & Hsinchu City PeiYing Junior High School. The program is part of NYCU's effort in facilitating local connections by engaging overseas students in the local communities. NYCU overseas students are invited to give lectures in local middle school on SDGs related issues or topics and create an immersive English learning environment for local students. NYCU overseas students interested in interacting with the local community are welcome to join this program!

- Funding and support for NYCU participants:

- 1) Free round-trip transportation on lecture days (NYCU – Peiying)
- 2) Hourly pay for the lecture is NTD 1,000 (with NTD 600 from PeiYing and NTD 400 from NYCU) and totally 2 hours of teaching on each lecture day (NTD 2,000/day)

Requirements

- Eligibility: Overseas students (international students and overseas Chinese students with a valid work permit) currently enrolled at the Chiaotung Campus of NYCU
- Language requirement: Fluent English. The OIA will assign one local student to assist in the class if the applicants are not fluent in Chinese.
- Vaccination requirements: pass COVID-19 antigen test (rapid test) within 72 hours prior to lecture day or have received two shots of COVID-19 vaccines for at least 14 days prior to lecture days (valid vaccination certificate is required). Students recently entering Taiwan should complete quarantine and self-health management first before joining this event.

Lecture Themes

SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals) related topics; for example, life and land, environmental sustainability, energy saving, good health and well-being etc. Students can introduce the background, culture or history in relation to the SDGs or with their home country. Students are suggested to insert video clip to their PPT.
